Invitation:

For the 2020 event we are looking for abstracts for posters on any topic relating to Learning from Excellence. We are particularly interested in abstracts which are related to the event theme: **Why Language Matters**

Format:

Please use an Appreciative Inquiry (AI) framework for your submission. This is not essential but fits with the theme of the event. The questions below are intended as a guide to structuring this.

Define:	Title of project
Discover:	Why did you choose this project? What did the project involve? What has the impact been? Have there been any unexpected benefits?
Dream:	Imagine, in a year's time your project has expanded in unexpected and generative ways: what would this look like? What kinds of things have happened?
Design:	How do you plan to develop this? Who will help to the spread and development? What challenges will you have overcome?
Destiny:	How will you share learning in this area?

Word count maximum **300 words**
