



WHAT’S THIS ALL ABOUT?

Learning from Excellence (LFE) is an approach to safety in healthcare developed by Dr. Adrian Plunkett that focuses on "what went well" as compared to our traditional reporting systems of focusing on failures to prevent recurrence

HOW DOES IT WORK?

- Email address is set up to receive feedback
- LFE member responds to all submissions, forwards reply to receiver and their supervisor
- LFE Committee meets monthly
- Review submissions and assign themes
- Choose one or two for appreciative inquiry

LFE AIM: TO BOOST MORALE THROUGH POSITIVE FEEDBACK



OUR TIMELINE

June 2019



- Survey to members of the ICN multidisciplinary team, asking how individuals like to be recognized and how they recognize others
- A presentation about the concept of LFE was provided to staff

July 2019

- ICN Learning from Excellence Outlook e-mail account started and made available to staff to submit observations and recognition

February 2020

- Survey to staff to measure change in feedback and recognition practices, value of process




APPRECIATIVE INQUIRY

A method for reflection on a report



- What happened?

- We have received 112 submissions
- Themes have included Patient Safety, Teamwork and a Willingness to Help

- Submissions have included multiple departments and disciplines
